




Dubai Art fair 2009

The Gallery was also very active in promoting Syrian and Arab art internationally and has contributed to various publications on the region's art scene. Thanks to its unwavering commitment excellence and its belief in the region's significant artistic disciplines, Atassi Gallery continues to be one of the prominent artistic venues in the Middle East.



Although he had first studied classical calligraphy, Ahmad Moualla's early works consisted of figurative and mostly socially-critical themes. In the last few years, Ahmad has returned to integrate calligraphy in his works, thereby illustrating how both themes can be united artistically, whilst avoiding the decorative limitations of the Arabic Script. His works push the boundaries between script and painting by playing around with the legibility of the words. Born in Syria in 1958, Ahmad Moualla graduated from the Damascus University of Fine Arts and then continued at the Ecole National Superieure des Beaux Arts in Paris. Since then he has participated in various exhibitions in Dubai, Cairo, Paris, Istanbul, Bahrain, Kuwait, Austria and Germany, among many others and his work was also included in the 2007 Sotheby's Modern and Contemporary Arab and Iranian Auction which took place in London. He is the recipient of various awards including the Lattakia Biennale and most recently, the Al Burda Prize in the UAE.




Abu Al Tayeb Al Moutannabi 200X200cm Acrylic on canvas 2008








